

Event Line-ups for Regular-Season Tournaments, Round-Robin Events, etc.: At the start of a weekend tournament or round robin competition, each coach must provide the host coach with an event line-up that lists all of the participating players in ladder order, with number one being the strongest player, number two the next strongest, and so on. The event line-up may list up to twenty players if necessary, and each player's position should reflect their most recent challenges and their position in previous match line-ups, as required by CSA guidelines. The host coach of a weekend tournament or round robin will post the event line-ups for review by all other coaches.

If a player misses the first part of a tournament or is dropped from a team's playing line-up at some point during the event, they can be placed back into the playing line-up in the same position listed in the event line-up.
